INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTERS:

To vote, complete the oval to the LEFT of your choice, like this . Use only a marking device provided by a poll worker. If you fill more than one oval, your vote will not count. If you make a mistake on your ballot, return it to an election official for a replacement ballot. You may replace up to two ballots in an election.

Shall the Board of Directors continue the effectiveness of Fort Smith Ordinance No. 72-85, which levies a local sales (gross receipts) and use tax at the rate of one percent (1%) upon the receipt from the sale at retail within the City of Fort Smith of all items which are subject to taxation under the Arkansas Sales Tax Act (Arkansas Gross Receipts Tax Act of 1941, Act 386 of the 1941 Acts of Arkansas), as said Act has heretofore or may hereinafter be amended, provided that the maximum local sales (gross receipts) and use tax on any single item of sale or use shall continue to be in the tax sum of \$25.00 which proceeds from such tax shall, subject to the voter approval otherwise, continue to be designated for City streets, bridges and associated drainage?
